

The higher the temperature above zero, the greater the toll in frozen food quality. A day's storage life is used up for each day food is stored at zero. One day at 10 degrees consumes eight days time, and at 20 degrees, 56 days storage are used up.

Quality losses accumulate from storage below zero degrees. Missiones advises. Feeling a package to see if it is hard-frozen is not a reliable guide to quality. The package could have been thawed and refrozen.
