



Falmoth va Febuary 27 1863 Dear Sister

I am well and heaty hoping this may find you the Same as you Say things is high up there there are high and Scare down here there is nothing going on here worth noticeing timer is dull here the Soldiers are all down hearted here But I am gay and happy they Cant hurt me unless they kill me and they will have to Be Sharp if they do that. you wanted me to tell you if I wanted any thing I do not want thing. I am well provided with every thing But Stamps and I Cant get them here no how So you my Send me fifty Cencts worth if you will I guess that is all I want at this time

I am a private But I will Be raised after while But don't Say nothing write Soor Sethere and write Soon Direct as usua

I am a private But I will Be raised after while But dont Say nothing I want to kill another rebel then I will Be ready to Come home I must now Close my letter from your Brother David Lilley Company C. write Soon David To Annie Be Shure and write Soon
