Dear Neighbor,

It has been the honor of my life to serve our country and the State of Delaware in uniform. No one sacrifices more to keep us safe than the men and women of the United States Armed Forces. And no one works harder than my friend Senator Tom Carper to make sure we take care of these brave heroes and their families when they return from serving our country. Tom is a 23-year veteran of the Navy and Navy Reserves, and I've worked with him over the years to support and protect our Delaware National Guard, including the eight years he served as our Commander in Chief. Tom has also vigorously defended and expanded health care, education, and employment opportunities for our veterans in Delaware and across the country.

Tom has helped transform services for veterans here in Delaware. Tom supports and protects the new GI Bill, which can cover the full cost of tuition at UD, DSU, Del Tech, Wilmington University, and other public colleges and universities. Tom was able to attend the University of Delaware thanks to the Vietnam Era GI Bill. He knows how important it is for the federal government to support and protect veterans' education benefits. Tom is a leader in the U.S. Senate on holding predatory for-profit colleges accountable when they try to exploit our veterans and service members.

Tom also understands our obligation to ensure that our veterans can return home and succeed in the civilian workforce. That means doing all we can to help veterans find meaningful and good-paying jobs. Since 2011, Tom has co-hosted Veterans Jobs Fair to connect hundreds of veterans to employers. No one in the Senate is doing more to make our air and water cleaner, while also taking on climate change and strengthening our economy at the same time. As the


