How To Read The Course Evaluation

1) FIND THE COURSE NUMBER AND NAME, AND THE INSTRUCTOR'S NAME.

You may have trouble finding the instructor's name. We received our information from the records office and in some cases the instructor listed had the class only one day or not at all, while the instructor who actually taught the course was not on the list. Many students evaluated these courses anyway, therefore the averages corresponding to some few courses cannot be ascribed to the instructor on the list. Blanks: in some instances the records office did not have any instructor's name listed. Graduate level courses, seminars, and special projects were eliminated from the evaluation. Unfortunately there are a few undergraduate courses missing from the records office list also.

2) THE AVERAGES OBTAINED FROM ALL THOSE WHO EVALUATED A SPECIFIC COURSE ARE IN A STRAIGHT LINE ACROSS THE PAGE.

The average of the first question is in column A, the second average is in column B etc. Rip off the questionnaire at the end of the first page to facilitate reading the averages.

3) THE PERCENT FOR EACH COURSE IS THE PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS WHO,

OUT OF THE ENTIRE NUMBER THAT TOOK THE COURSE, EVALUATED THE COURSE.

Some instructors taught more than one section of the same course. In this case the total number of students from all of his sections were added to determine his class. What is a good percentage? This depends on how reliable one wants to be. Most students use the opinion of only one or two persons when deciding whether to take a course. Any response of over ten percent then could be considered a fair estimate.

PROBLEMS

The organization of the course evaluation was not easy. It necessitated much time and labor and problems still persist. The grid form was difficult to blacken in but it had to be specially designed in order that the computer could read it. Some of those students who filled out the evaluation complained of a lack of course-instructor name lists. Costs were high and so we were limited in purchasing these limits.

REPLIES

A good number of the undergraduate student body filled out the questionnaire. AWS did a wonderful job collecting the evaluations from the women's dorms. APO collected from the men's dorms and a table was installed in the Student Center for the commuters. Our sample may be slightly biased due to the fact that more women filled out the evaluations than did men. But this will probably result in Engineering and other typically male courses having a smaller percentage of answers, rather than prejudicing our entire evaluation. Many of the student body of course didn't want to be bothered to take the time and effort to participate in the course evaluation. These are probably the same students who couldn't be bothered to vote or do anything else around this university. Many thanks to all the students who evaluated their courses and especially to Bonnie Nelson and "Bushy Mane" for their months of work and years of patience.
