March 23. 1864

Dear Doctor

Enclosed an order restoring me to command. The Secretary ^{of War} had by a telegraphic order to Genl. Morris forbid the muster in of any one in my place. This was Corliss's physical disability for the position.

I told you I would come back. If it had not been the spontaneous wish of every soldier of the Regt. I would not.

My triumph is complete - no body remains in the Regt. now to fight.

Tell John Graham to put all my clothes in my trunk - Some things are hanging up in the rooms at Mrs. S. and send it to the Relay. I will not be up for several days. I want my trunk sent down at once - Tell old L. M. to bring it & want to see him. Show Rank my order
