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The Auditor feels it his duty, at the close of his official services, to call the attention of the Committee and of the General Assembly to the fact that the School Districts of the State frequently sustain losses of considerable amount by the School Committees, who fail to expend the moneys in their hands for the benefit of the Districts. This evil is sadly on the increase, and should not some remedy be applied these losses must continue to occur in increased amounts. It will be seen by reference to my statement of the settlement made with the Committees of the several Districts of the State, that the sum of \$11,206.79 cents remains unexpended in the hands of the Committees, while only \$374.91 cents has been overpaid.

I would suggest that it is important the Legislature should discover some means to secure the proper expenditure of the money the State appropriates, and by which the Committees who handle it shall discharge their duties with fidelity.
